When you have completed an Associate of Arts/Associate of Science degree or 60 units with 24 core units in Child Development, 16 units in the general education categories listed above, 6 administration units, and 2 adult supervision units and the experience requirement, you may apply for your Site Supervisor Permit.

The Child Development program at Modesto Junior College is designed to meet the academic requirements of the Modesto Junior College Child Development Certificates and the academic requirements of the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing for the Child Development Permits, Title 5. In addition, courses designated for the Associate Teacher will meet the academic requirements of Title 22, Community Care Licensing, for a fully qualified teacher. Students are advised to follow the suggested flow of courses that meet MJC graduation requirements as well.
