Overall Grading Standards:

- Good** Well developed reflections that are weak in some aspects; does not address all aspects of project's objectives and guidelines; limited critical thinking that lacks deep analysis; may lack in organization and presentation of ideas; some mistakes in technical competency; and limited originality or creativity when completing assigned work.
- Poor** Displays technical incompetence; serious problems in development, presentation, creativity and critical thinking; several portions of the project are missing; does not meet minimum requirements of the project; and little understanding of the project is demonstrated.
