

## **INTD 230- DRAFTING FOR INTERIORS**

Required texts: Construction Drawings & Details for Interiors, by Otie & Rosemary Kilmer.

Interior Visual Presentation, by Maureen Mitten

NOTE: Check with instructor to see what supplies the school can provide . Students will be required to sign out for all materials and must be returned upon request. Thank you for your co-operation.

### **REQUIRED TOOLS AND MATERIAL:**

- 24”T square with wood and plastic “blade”
- 12-18” T square for smaller detailing ( may be plastic)
- Lead holder, clam shell type. 3color holders. Leads: 2B, 2H & 4H. Refer to Manual for description.
- Rotating wheel pointer for mechanical lead holder pencils
- Kneaded & gum erasers
- Title Block printed drafting vellum, 18 x 24 (Clear print 1000, on line or bookstore)..
- On line source: Direct from Clearprint,Inc., or Dick Blick Art.
- 11 x 14 Visualizer paper: Canson Pro Layout Smooth, or similar “visualizer” grade. @18lb paper
- Triangle: Clear plastic 45/90: 8 or 10 inch leg
- Triangle: 30/60-8-10inches
- Small set of the above triangles 4-6inches
- NOTE: TRIANGLES SHOULD NOT HAVE INKING EDGE/ NO BEVEL EDGES
- Architects Scale ruler, plastic or wood, not metal (NOT ENGINEERING SCALE!)
- Circle guide template, assortment of diameters on single template( Buy Online “Templates”).
- Drafting tape or dots
- Retractable 12 foot tape measure
- Basic classroom type compass (wheel adjusting, not manual spreading)
- Plastic template for Interior Designers: ¼ scale for furnishing and interior details
- Large construction paper portfolio with handle to transport and hold supplies
- Small utility box to carry supplies, your selection.
- 3 ring binder, 3” size for handouts, manual PP.,and assignments

NOTE : Although most supplies are available locally, it is recommended to SHOP for best price,however,strict adherence to the above specs. is required.
